The Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) today approved a settlement agreement authorizing AT&T Michigan to eliminate its \$2.78 end-user common line charge (EUCL) and to increase its monthly primary basic local exchange service (PBLES) rate by \$1.78 effective June 1. The result is a net \$1 decrease in customers' monthly bills. . . .

. . . AT&T Michigan filed an application on Sept. 1, 2006 to increase its monthly PBLES rate by the amount of its intrastate EUCL charge, effective June 1. The Michigan Telecommunications Act allows telecommunications providers to increase their PBLES rates by an amount equal to the EUCL, which was eliminated.

The parties in the case - the MPSC staff, Attorney General Michael A. Cox and AARP - reached a settlement agreement on March 19. The settlement also prohibits any PBLES increase before Dec. 31, 2008.

The MPSC is an agency within the Department of Labor & Economic Growth.

On April 3, 2007 the Michigan Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issued an Order rescinding the license of Universal Access, Inc. The license had been issued on April 24, 2000. The Commission also ordered Universal Access, Inc. to surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it. On October 27, 2006, Universal Access, Inc. indicated its intent to surrender the license and stated that it has no customers in Michigan and has ceased operations in Michigan.

On April 3, 2007 the Michigan Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issued an Order accepting a settlement agreement between AT&T Michigan, the Commission Staff, Attorney General Michael A. Cox, and AARP Michigan, allowing AT&T to increase its monthly rate for Primary Basic Local Exchange Service (“PBLES”) by \$1.78, effective June 1, 2007, simultaneous with the elimination of its \$2.78 intrastate end-user common line (“EUCL”) charge. The Settlement further provides that AT&T will not increase its PBLES rate before December 31, 2008, and none of the parties to the settlement agreement will seek to reduce the monthly PBLES rate before that date. AT&T had initially applied to increase its monthly PBLES rate by the amount of its intrastate EUCL charge (\$2.78), effective June 1, 2007.

Video Franchise

On April 2, 2007, AT&T Michigan filed with the Michigan Public Service Commission (“Commission”) a Petition for Resolution of a Dispute with the Township of Gross Ile (“Township”) under the Uniform Video Services Franchise Act (the “Act”), MCL 484.3301 *et seq.* According to the Petition, on March 26, 2007, AT&T submitted a Commission approved Proposed Video Franchise Agreement. On March 30, 2007, the Township notified AT&T that the Proposed Video Franchise Agreement was incomplete because “the service provider information referenced is inaccurate and liability responsibility has not been addressed.” AT&T seeks a Commission determination that its Proposed Video Franchise Agreement is complete and that the township “erroneously and unlawfully determined that” it was incomplete under the terms of the Act and the Commission’s Order in MPSC Case No. U-15169. AT&T also seeks a Commission Order that the Township has until April 25, 2007 to approve the Proposed Video Franchise Agreement.
