

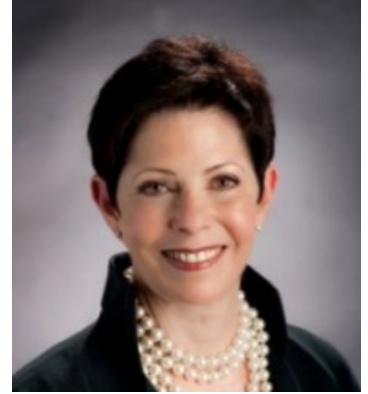
Ada S. Kerwin
