Sue holds certifications as a Certified Information Privacy Professional (CIPP/US) and a Certified Information Privacy Manager (CIPM) through the International Association of Privacy Professionals (IAPP). Sue served as a co-chair of the IAPP's Los Angeles Chapter for the past two years and is actively involved in the privacy community to keep abreast of privacy's evolving legal issues impacting her clients.
