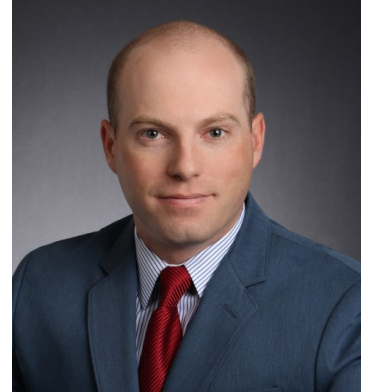


Timothy D. Lee
